Carbon Literacy is “An awareness of the carbon costs and impacts of everyday activities and the ability and motivation to reduce emissions on an individual, community and organisational basis.”

This training runs over 4 2-hour interactive sessions. To complete the course and be certified as Carbon Literate then you will need to attend all four sessions. The course will provide insight to help individuals and companies make informed choices to reduce their carbon impact.
