

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AWARD

In a world where the chemical supply chain is often seen unfavourably by residents living in and around the organisation's location, this award aims to recognise member companies who can demonstrate varying qualities and commitment to their communities. This may be through a community partnership programme or funding scheme and can be based on any theme including: social, health/wellbeing, educational, sustainable or environmental. Projects can be focused locally, nationally or globally but should demonstrate a significant impact to that community

Judges will be looking for evidence of how a project has

- Influenced the community
- How many people it has engaged
- What the lasting benefits will be & what the economic or social knock-on effect is that the project has created for the community

Assessment of the project's success will focus on creativity, innovation, integration and other impacts that foster improved relations and include quantifiable benefits for the community group

Particular note will be taken of programmes and projects that are aimed at improving community services, products and quality of life

How to Enter

To enter this award simply describe (in less than 750 words) how your business has demonstrated industry leadership and excellence within your community. This might relate to a specific initiative or project. It could be as a whole company, or a group of individuals within your company.

Showcase the work your company has done either with your local community or further afield. Whatever you choose, it will be something that has made a difference to the community in question and is truly class leading.

In addition to a 750 word submission, we encourage you to include any supporting material, pictures, and



testimonials that you believe will help the judges. Please ensure that any/all supporting documents are submitted in the order you wish them to be read either by numbering them appropriately (e.g. a, b, c, / 1, 2, 3, / i, ii, iii, / etc) or by adding/inserting them at the end of your entry document

You should also forward a high quality company logo (for publicity material). A vector format such as .eps or .ai is preferred.
