

YOUNG PERSON AWARD

We are passionate about encouraging and inspiring young people within the chemical supply chain and are looking for the young superstars of tomorrow that have already significantly contributed to and enhanced your business in any area. We are looking to recognise excellence within our industry and celebrating our extraordinary young people, the industry's future leaders, is a great start

The award is open to any person under 30 years of age on the 30th June 2024, who is employed by a member of the Chemical Business Association and is nominated by their Line Manager or Director. Anyone leaving their employer between the application and the presentation event, should inform the Chemical Business Association, as this would disqualify them from the award

All shortlisted candidates will be asked to attend an interview (usually online) with the Judging Panel to further expand on their suitability for this award. The winner of the award will be invited to join CBA's Future Council

How to Enter

The candidate should write an entry statement (of no more than 750 words) explaining their role in the company plus the impact they have made whilst in this role, their employment history, experience, etc, and why they should win the award. The judges will particularly be looking for evidence of:

- Measurable impact and/or projects successfully completed that have positively affected the company
- Instances where the candidate has introduced new ideas, processes, or products
- Demonstrated leadership and the ability to inspire and motivate others
- Participated in relevant courses, certifications, conferences, or seminars
- Involvement in industry groups and/or forums
- Activities that promote the sector, such as careers outreach, writing articles, or social media engagement
- Strategic contributions to the company's direction and long-term goals
- Contributions to CSR initiatives or sustainable practices within the company
- Ability to adapt to change and overcome challenges



- Demonstrated ethical behaviour and integrity
- The ability to work well in a team and collaborate with colleagues across departments

The candidate's entry statement should be supported by their Line Manager or a Director of the company, explaining (in no more than 500 words) why they have been nominated and further expanding on their achievements within the company

In addition to your 750 word submission and the Line Manager's statement, we encourage candidates to include any supporting material, pictures, and testimonials that you believe will help the judges. Please ensure that any/all supporting documents are submitted in the order you wish them to be read either by numbering them appropriately (e.g. a, b, c, / 1, 2, 3, / i, ii, iii, / etc) or by adding/inserting them at the end of your entry document

Each entry should be accompanied by a high quality company logo (for publicity purposes). A vector format such as .eps or .ai is required
